



## Army Families Federation Factsheet: Living in Cyprus Information for disabled drivers

Parking restrictions: There are some parking bays marked for disabled drivers in municipal car parks but they are few and far between and will often be used by non disabled drivers. According to the laws of the Republic of Cyprus, no one can park on a double yellow line, but you will find that most local people in Cyprus park mostly wherever they want to. However, there are traffic wardens and Cyprus is becoming stricter on enforcing the parking and driving regulations.

If you are buying a car in Cyprus only the serving member of the family can buy the car duty free. A dependant can then drive the car but cannot register a vehicle.

With regard to disabled people being exempted from road tax, you will be able to find out more from the Inland Transport Department & Licencing Authority, Ministry of Communications and Works. A disabled person can be exempted from road tax pending an application which has to be filed with them. For more information, their contact numbers are: 00357 22 807139 or 22 807137. In Cyprus, only the registered owner can apply for the road tax.
