



## Accessing the AFF Training Centre (Bulford)

Access to the building is gained from a ramp leading up to the front door.

For purposes of registration and enquiries, visitors to the centre are welcome to bring children and will be able to bring pushchairs into the main reception area (please note that side-by-side double pushchairs will not fit through the main door). In the event that you do visit the centre with children, we ask that they are properly supervised while on the premises, for their own safety and that of others.

We regret that the centre is not fully accessible to individuals who use a wheelchair. Classrooms for IT-based courses and bathroom facilities are all upstairs in the building although book-keeping courses will be offered in a ground floor classroom from early 2009.

### Parking

The Training Centre is directly opposite a large car park, with plenty of free parking spaces.

For anyone with a physical disability, there is sufficient space in the car park to ensure car doors can be fully opened.

### Facilities

The following facilities are available at the centre:

- 2 IT classrooms, each upstairs
- 2 bathrooms, each upstairs
- A student kitchen (fridge included)
- Tea and coffee facilities (at a small cost per course)
- A student break room

A photocopier is available to learners for purposes of copying course materials. (Photocopying for personal use is allowed, but it must be carried out by a member of the Training Centre staff and there is a small charge per sheet.)

### Smoking

In compliance with national legislation and MoD policy, smoking is not permitted in the Training Centre. Students may smoke outside the building but are asked to be considerate of others accessing the Centre.
